Waloven Tie # 293a 1.3 Miles

Recommended Season
Summer Fall

ACCESS: From Libby, head south on US Highway 2 for 28 miles and take the Silver Butte Road. Proceed up Silver Butte for 8.2 miles to a spur road on the left and the Waloven Himes and Waloven Tie Trailhead.

FACILITIES: None. Good trailer turn around and parking at the Trailhead.

SETTING: Closed canopy forest.

OPPORTUNITIES: Hiking, viewing scenery, horseback riding, and hunting.

ATTRACTIONS & CONSIDERATIONS:

The main attraction for this trail is access to the Silver Butte Ridge and Waloven Himes Trails. There are scenic views at the Silver Butte Fisher River crossing and Waloven Creek.

TRAIL INFORMATION: This trail was constructed to access Silver Butte Ridge Trail and move the access to the Waloven Himes Trail off private land.

The first ¼ mile is on an old skid road to the Silver Butte Fisher River Crossing. There is an excellent foot bridge over the river with a stock crossing just upstream from the bridge. Within the next mile there are two sections where the trail has washed out, but a path has been sawed out to get around them. Trail #293a ends at the junction of the Silver Butte Ridge Trail and the Waloven Himes Trail. There are no signs at this junction.

ELEVATION: Beginning at 3520 at the Trailhead to 3480 at the junction of Silver Butte Ridge and Waloven Himes Trails.

USE: Low

DIFFCULTY: Easy

MAINTENANCE: Periodically cleared by Cabinet Back Country Horsemen.


